The Itawamba Historical Society is a non-profit Mississippi organization dedicated to preserving the rich history and heritage of Itawamba County, Mississippi. The society operates the George Potteet History Center, the Gaither Spradling Library and Historic Bonds House Museum.

This grass-roots organization also publishes *Itawamba Settlers* magazine, a quarterly publication containing approximately 56 pages devoted entirely to Itawamba County, Mississippi history and genealogy.

Take time to discover the Itawamba Historical Society online! A visit to The Itawamba Historical Society Online Archives can be most productive with your research – a place where you can research your Itawamba County, Mississippi family history and heritage.

Welcome to the Itawamba Historical Society Online. The society's online presence contains many areas for you to pursue. From the main entrance at <http://www.itawambahistory.org>, there are links to various online areas.

The online archives area is perhaps the most visited area of the society's online presence. Here the researcher will find all types of archival data – from abstracts and transcripts to digital images of Itawamba County's past. The entire collection can be searched from the entrance page, or the various files can be browsed from a drop-down menu. The actual archives page can also be visited. The Itawamba Historical Society is publishing various archival information online. This information includes abstracts of early Itawamba County

records, digital images of source documents, archival photographs and maps, county histories and other valuable research information. Be sure to visit the Itawamba Historical Society's Online

Archives contents page for a listing of what is available online.

The society has plans to continue publishing Itawamba County research files online. Be sure to visit often to see what has

been added to the site. The society also invites visitors to submit old Itawamba County documents to be included in this online archives. Items such as old family photographs, Bible records, old family letters, store ledgers and such are solicited.

The Society Quarterly Magazine area of the website contains information about



Itawamba Settlers – the quarterly membership journal. This area includes a preview of the current issue, a table of contents for all current-year issues, a surname index for each volume published over the past few years, a cumulative table of contents and a topical index of every issue published since 1981.

The Special Online Publications area contains links to special online publications produced by the historical society, including many digital images of source documents. These publications are also listed in the online archives area.

Other links on the society's main website takes the visitor to other society areas including information about Historic Bonds House – Itawamba County's Museum of History, The George Poteet History Center and the Gaither Spradling Library. There is also a research links area where links to important offsite resources are posted, a membership information area and a contact area where the society's contact information is

published including e-mail addresses, physical address, mailing address, and a map showing the location of the society's facilities.

At the bottom of the society's main webpage is a link to the society's web log (blog) *Itawamba History Review*. Be sure to visit this publication as this area is updated most every day with informative articles about Itawamba County's rich history and heritage, scenic photographs of Itawamba County, research articles and genealogy news. Readers also have the ability to interact with the editor through posting comments.

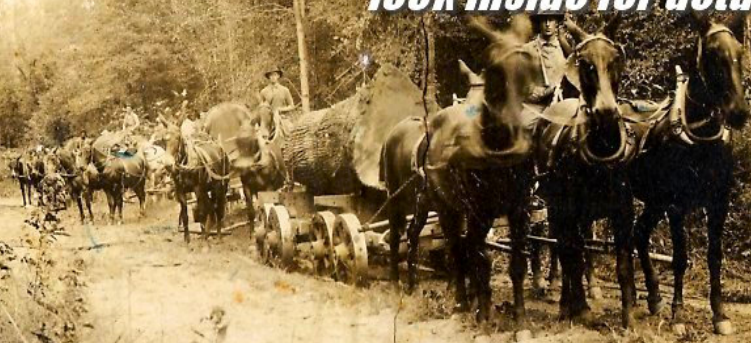
